Please read the excellent letter our Access Trails Coordinator, Jim Terlep, has written to the Director, Pima County Regional Flood Control District, Suzanne Shields. Jim's letter clearly states our opposition to the proposal of building a new model airplane airstrip near an existing parking lot and staging area for hikers, bicyclists, and equestrians who use the parking lot to access the CDO portion of the Loop trail system at Overton Road.

My request is that our club members read Jim's letter and see what is involved and then write your own letters/emails to Suzanne Shields opposing the proposed model airplane airstrip. The more letters received from our membership the better. And the sooner the better. So please join the parade as it affects several of our SAHC Urban Trail segments and is fundamentally incompatible with the public use of this area. Thank you all for your interests and help in this matter.
